

## WACMA MEETING FEBRUARY 2, 2005

**Secretary's Report:** Dawn moved to accept –David seconded. All agreed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Report is up to date. Sue checked and we registered with Pick'N'Save. To date we have not received a check.

**Orchestra Report:** Next concert is Thursday, February 17<sup>th</sup>. This is a change from February 16<sup>th</sup>. Solo/Ensemble is March 19<sup>th</sup> at Hale. No other information at this time.

**Choir Report:** No new information.

**Fundraiser:** Dawn checked into a sale with Racine Kringles. Kringles would sell for \$7.00 and our profit would be \$2.25 or \$2.50 per kringle. Dawn will check to see if Racine Kringle will come out and do a Kick-Off for the sale and/or help with the Pick-Up. She will also find out if they will offer any samples of their products.

We would ask for a delivery date (Pick-up) of Tuesday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>. This would enable people to order and have their product for the Spring Break/Easter, which starts on March 24<sup>th</sup>. We can product delivered to Room 137, get some handcars and ask for some student helpers. This is a non-trip year, so students would get 75% of the profit, which would go into their individual accounts, WACMA, and Activity Funds would share the 25%.

Directors ask for advance notice of the kick-off activity, so they can plan how it affects classes, lessons, etc.

**New Business:** All City Orchestra will be on April 26<sup>th</sup> this year in the Central Field House. Booster Club usually sells soda and water at such events. WACMA would like to sell soda and water to boost our income a bit. We feel we should be allowed to do this since this is a music event and Boost Club does not support the Arts, just athletics.
